EdChoice & Emmaus Road Scholarship Application Policy

All families are required to apply for both EdChoice and Emmaus Road Scholarships <u>before parish grants will be applied</u> to tuition accounts. As a preferred source of funding, these state scholarships **save parishes money** and allow them to reallocate unused parish grant funds to those in most need. Once scholarships are awarded, the sponsoring parish will be notified, and the **suggested grant amount will be reduced if tuition is covered**.

Here are examples of how tuition for families of varying income levels with three students in each family might look with this new process. Note how the parish grant amounts are reduced after EdChoice Scholarships are applied.

Jon Peterson & Autism Scholarship Information

Students who are Jon Peterson or Autism scholarship-eligible are not eligible for EdChoice Scholarships, leaving their family with a greater financial responsibility than nonspecial needs families. In these cases, we ask the sponsoring parish to consult with the St. Francis School team and consider offering a higher grant amount (from monies saved from previously offered parish grants) to make tuition costs comparable to families of the same income level who are eligible to receive EdChoice Scholarships.
